Onset 14 November 2014

Increase of dead animals 1% prompts the farmer to call his vet.

Veterinarian

- Sends 5 carcasses from stable "9" to the Animal Health service
- Notifies the competent authority (obligation by national law)

The competent authority

- Asks the Animal Health service to take swabs of the carcasses for the National Reference Laboratory (CVI)

RESULT PCR positive H5

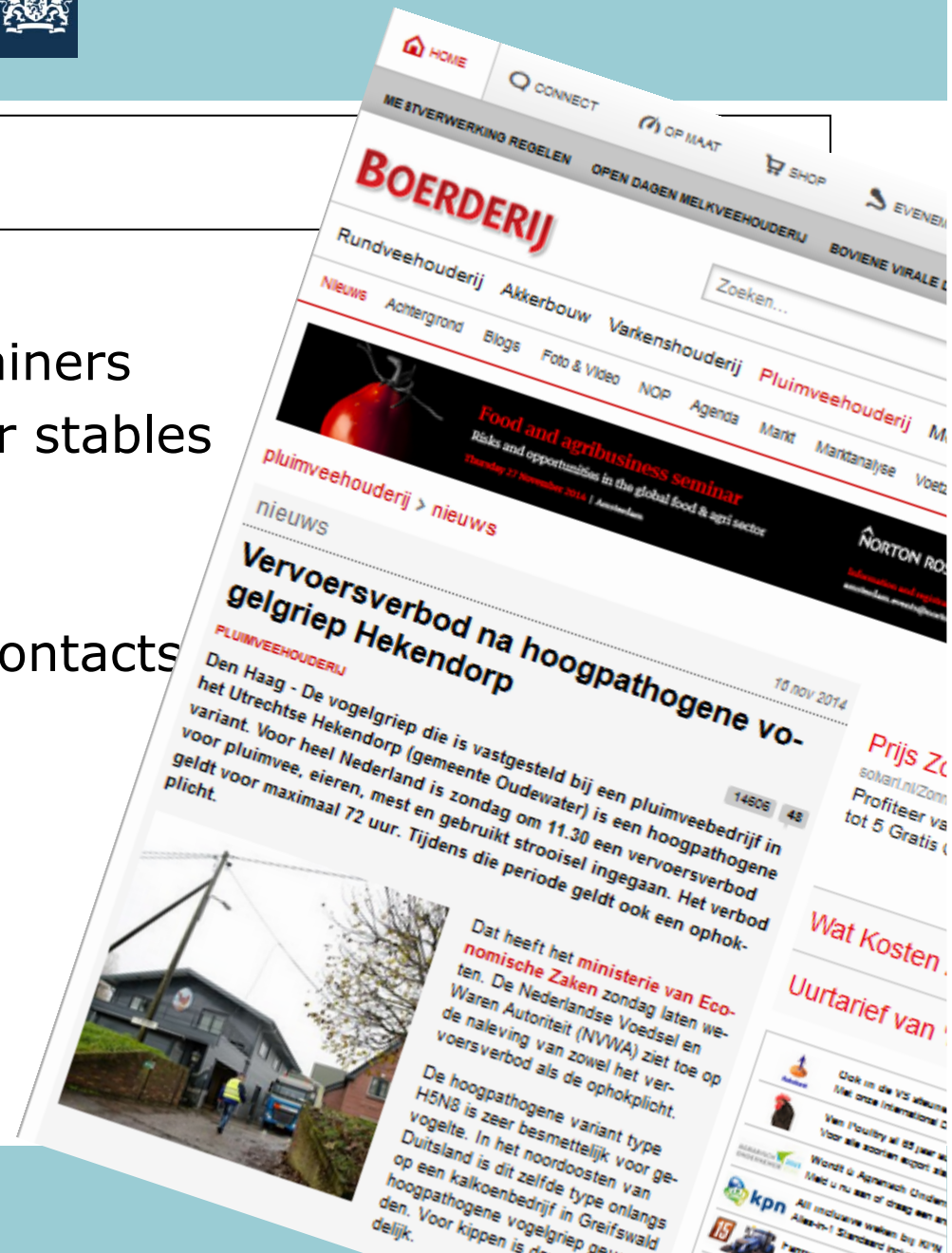

Enforcement standstill





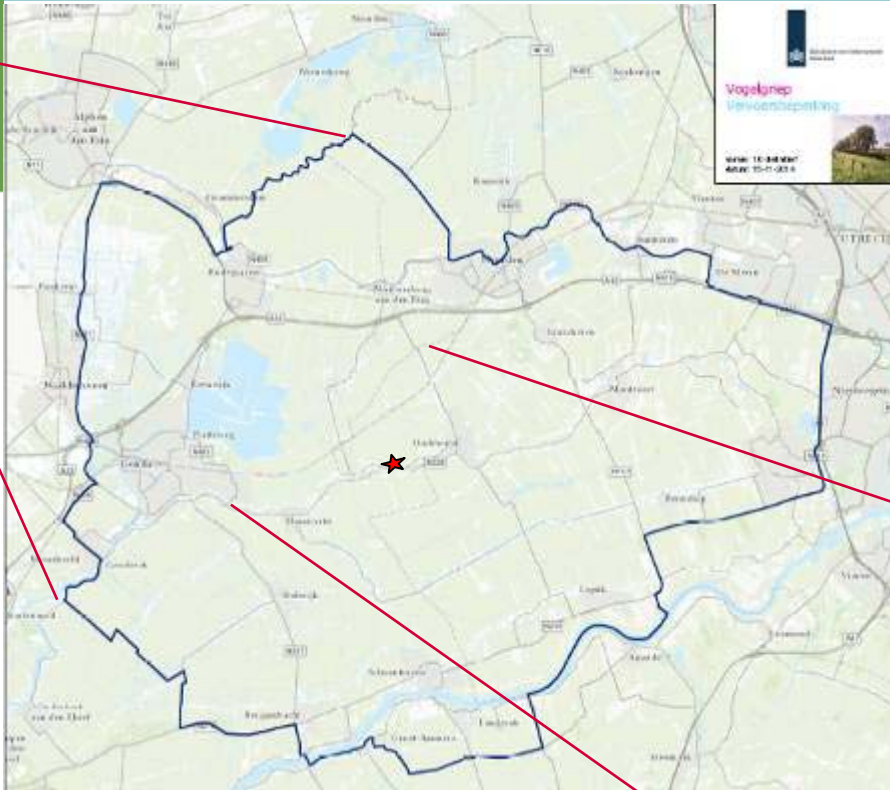
18 November 2014
