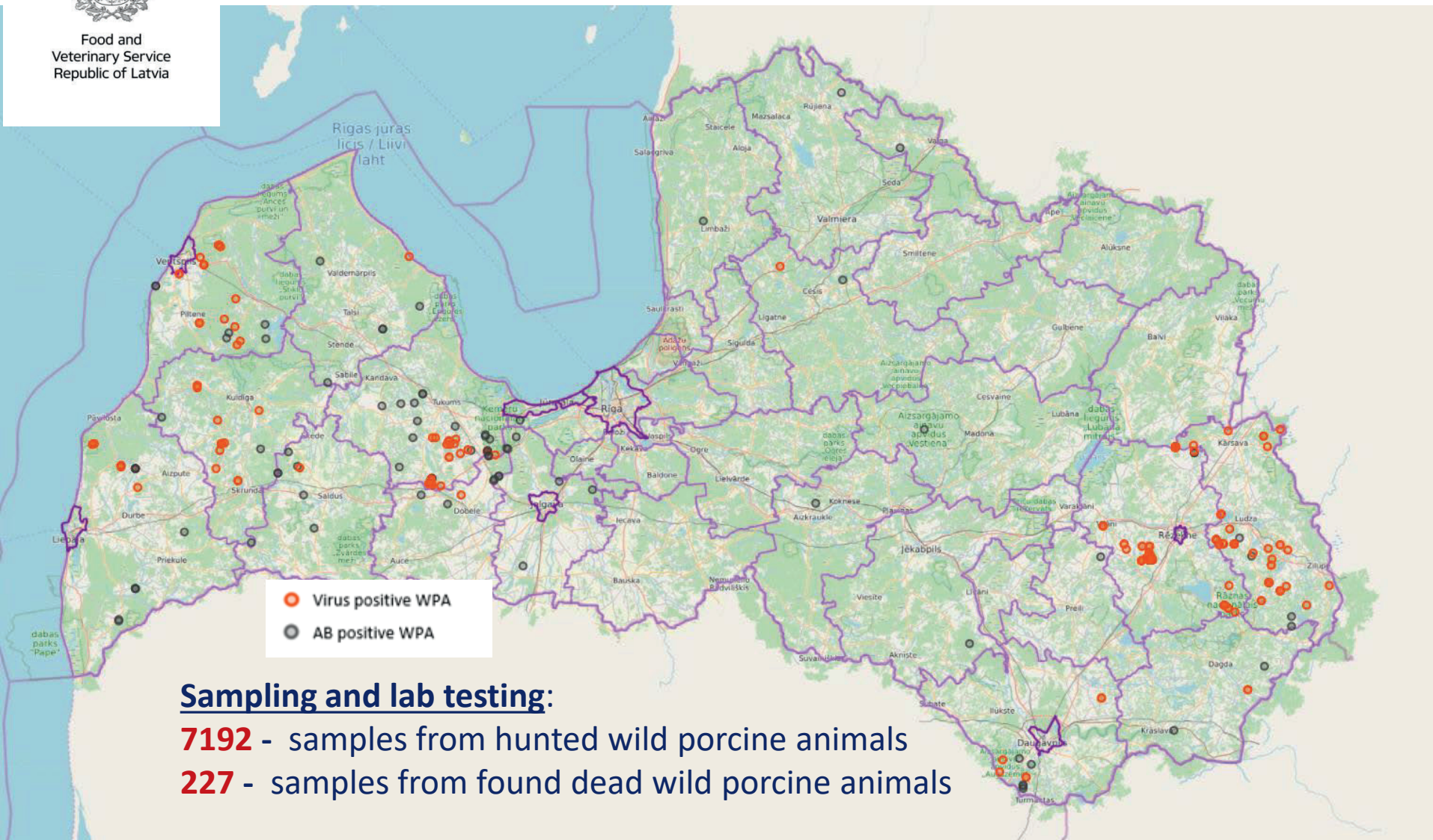
ASF epidemiological situation in Latvia – 2022 (update)

ASF cases in wild porcine animals in 2022 (to 1st April)



Sampling and lab testing:

7192 - samples from hunted wild porcine animals

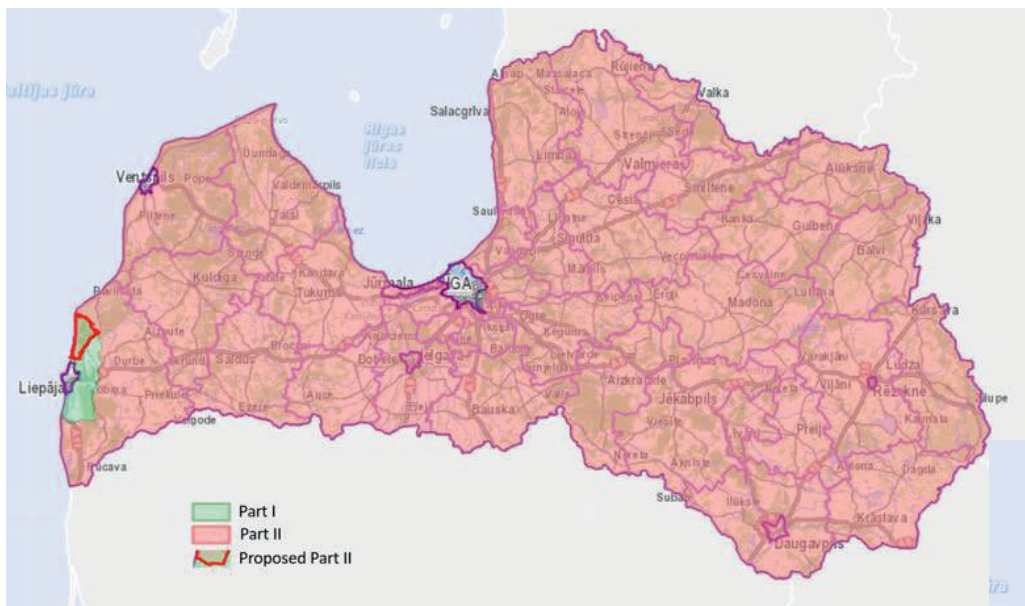
227 - samples from found dead wild porcine animals

In total, **315** ASF cases in wild porcine animals (133 hunted, 182 found dead)
ASF virus positive - 232 cases, seropositive - 83 cases

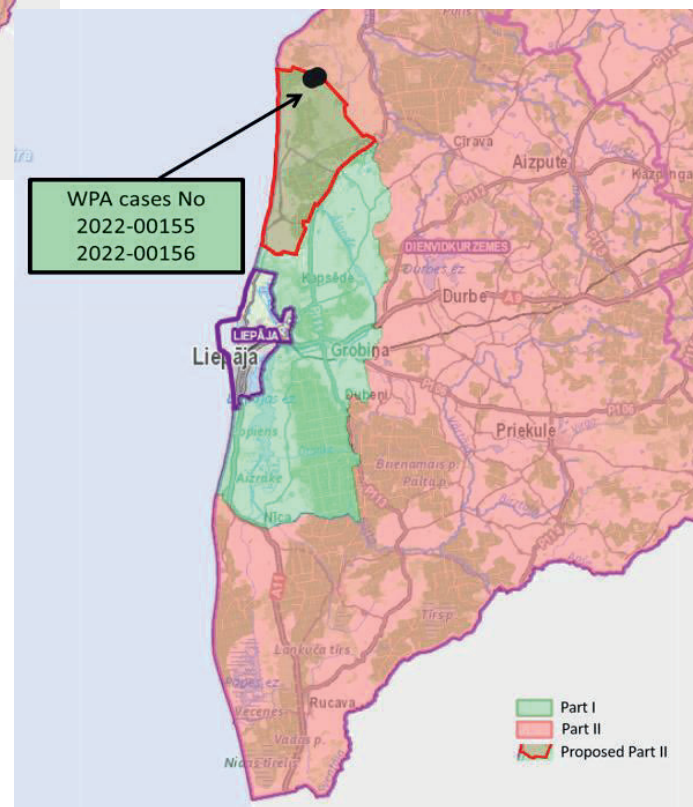

Enlargement of Part II (1)



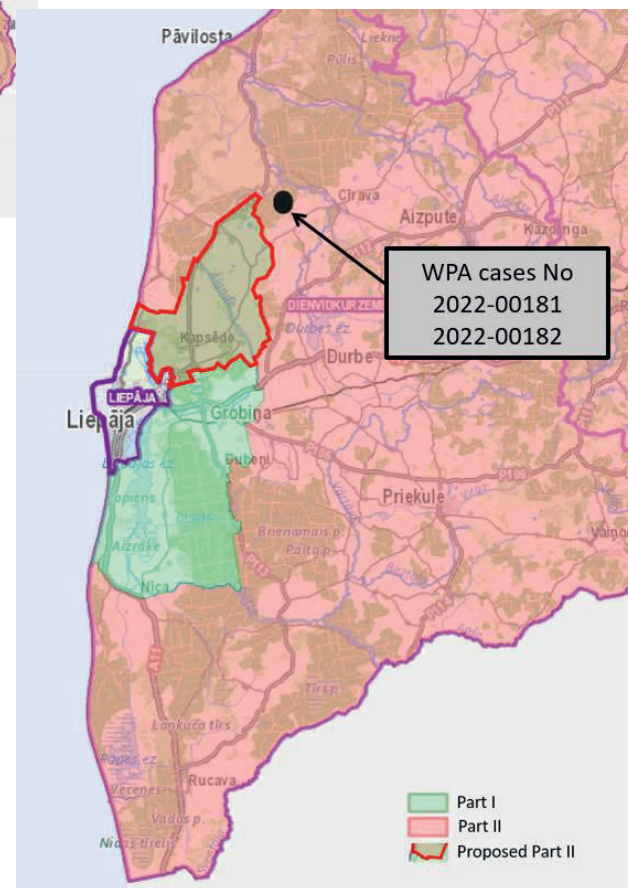
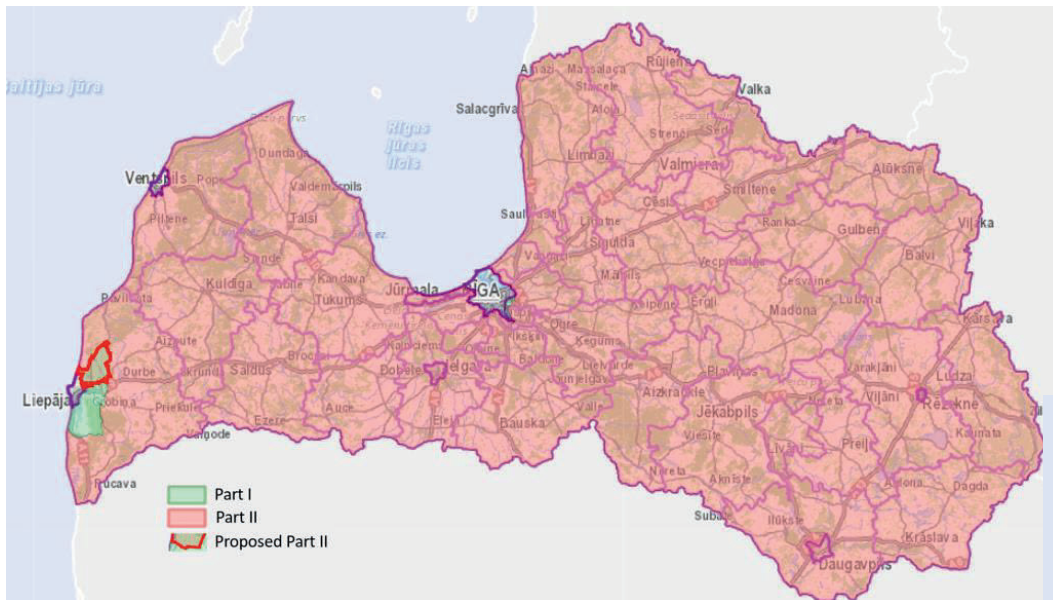
ASF was confirmed in six dead wild porcine animals on 16th March in the area listed in Part I (in the county of Dienvidkurzemes Vērgales parish)
