Public consultation Part V – Entry into the Union SUMMARY

- ✓ Total received within the EU: 27 feedbacks
 - ✓ 19 stakeholders (including poultry, aquaculture, equine, pets, pig and zoos associations)
 - ✓ 3 public authorities
 - ✓ 1 particular citizen
 - ✓ 4 anonymous

- ✓ Total received from TCs: 4 feedbacks (SPS notification)



Public consultation

Part V – Entry into the Union (I)

- ✓ Requests to reconsider the level of requirements in relation to the control of emerging diseases in third countries.
- ✓ Suggestions to add extra requirements regarding the compliance with other EU rules (i.e. responsible use of medicines and animal welfare).
 - ✓ Those rules apply by default in addition to AHL and supplementing legislation. There is no need to mention them in the Delegated act.

Public consultation

Part V – Entry into the Union (II)

- ✓ Requests to clarify the periodicity of the animal health visits in the establishment of origin of animals.
- ✓ Requests to extend the period to perform the inspection of animals prior to their dispatch in certain species and categories (equine animals).
- ✓ Request for a derogation regarding visible, legible and indelible identification display for ungulates intended for confined establishments.
- ✓ Request to include *Bos indicus* in the possible species of origin of fresh meat.
