# Two years process

## Where are we now?

- Desk Research ongoing
   Review of around 120 sources
- Interviews ongoing
  94 completed, 4 scheduled and new interviews planned
- **Survey** completed (1/04-8/05/2020) 101 responses collected on all five criteria
- **Public Consultation** ending on 22/06/2020 (after 13 weeks) More than 1000 responses (approx. 500 are a coordinated response)
- Case studies ongoing





# Some preliminary findings

- Based on data until 8 May interim study report
- Several consulations activities are still ongoing
- Triangulation of data is not finailised yet
- Further research is still ongoing





# Relevance

Question	Preliminary findings
To what extent did the objectives of the Strategy, its actions and other activities, properly address animal welfare needs at EU-level at the time?	<ul> <li>The Strategy correctly identified animal welfare needs in the EU.</li> <li>The model was overall appropriate.</li> <li>Some actions were more appropriate than others.</li> </ul>



# **Efficiency**

Question	Preliminary findings
To what extent could the same results have been achieved with fewer resources?	<ul> <li>The main benefits associated with the Strategy were improved compliance and enforcement</li> <li>Some enforcement actions have been identified as cost effective, while some other actions, has been identified as not costeffective.</li> <li>Further research is ongoing to explain this.</li> </ul>





### Coherence

Question	Preliminary findings
How well have the various components of the Strategy operated together and led to synergies to improve overall performance, over time and up until 2019?	<ul> <li>The different components of the Strategy were internally coherent and operate well together.</li> <li>Although synergies exist, some gaps have also been identified.</li> </ul>
