



As of 2nd March all restrictions were lifted



26.3.2020. Confirmation of H5N8 in Bács-Kiskun county – duck holding








HPAI outbreaks from March

By that date: 38 outbreaks in Bács-Kiskun county






30.4.2020. Confirmation of H5N8 in Békés county – turkey and geese holding

By that date: 227 outbreaks in Bács-Kiskun and Csongrád-Csanád counties






Situation on 5th June (last outbreak)






Situation after 15th June






Situation after 30th June

Epidemics in numbers

237 outbreaks in Bács-Kiskun county27 outbreaks in Csongrád-Csanád county5 outbreaks in Békés county

24 outbreaks confirmed fromtests taken before transport4 outbreaks confirmed fromtests of preventive killings

Depopulation (due to outbreaks, suspicion or preventive killing)

350 holdings in Bács-Kiskun county42 holdings in Csongrád-Csanád county7 holdings in Békés county

4 760 776 birds killed of which preventive killing: 1 102 182 birds



Epidemics in numbers - holdings



- 61 duck
 - 111 geese
- 56 mulard
- 22 Gallus gallus
- 9 turkey
 - 4 Gallus gallus+duck
 - 2 Gallus gallus+turkey
 - 1 pheasant+partridge
 - 1 guinea fowl+turkey
 - 1 Gallus gallus+peacock
 - 1 duck+geese

Numbers in the protection zones during the epidemic

Bács-Kiskun county Census: 1 144 910 animals Surveillance: 21 260 swabs in 254 holdings

Csongrád-Csanád county Census: 672 213 animals Surveillance: 11 834 swabs in 135 holdings

Békés county Census: 29 850 animals Surveillance: 1 270 swabs in 8 holdings



Numbers in the protection zones before restocking

Surveillance of holdings 95% specificity and 10% prevalence/zone

60 animals/holding (20 cloaca swabs, 20 trachea swabs, 20 blood samples)

Bács-Kiskun county: 20 commercial, 30 non-commercial holdings Csongrád-Csanád county: 2 commercial, 30 non-commercial holdings Békés county: 8 commercial, 30 non-commercial holdings



Restocking

in accordance with Council Directive 2005/94/EC

CVO order 3/2017 is still in force (poultry should be able to be closed if ordered, requirements on stocking density, etc.)

New restocking procedure introduced in the areas affected in the 2020 epidemic

- Developed in cooperation with the Poultry Product Board
- Statement of PPB and integrators taking into account the specifities of the sector
- Compulsory testing in force before moving for further keeping or for immediate slaughter
