


Location of the ND outbreaks







ND outbreaks in 2024 - summary

ND outbreaks occured in one region (Podlaskie). In total, 3 outbreaks were confirmed (111 464 birds in those outbreaks)


The whole **Podlaskie** region is considered as at risk of ND.

Due to current epidemiological situation, in **Podlaskie** region:

- owners of unvacinnated poultry must implement immediate vaccination actions for chickens and turkeys,
- in all hatcheries, vaccination actions of 1 day-old chicks and turkeys before the movement of consignments.

In general, vaccinations against ND, in the rest of the country, are **voluntary**.

Programme includes:

- all areas, where ND outbreaks were confirmed,
- areas of high poultry establishments contentration,
- areas of high wild birds population.

Samples taken:

- from game birds,
- from birds trapped by ornithologists,
- from birds in rehabilitation centers,
- from birds catched in the area of aquaculture establishments,
- from birds in vet clinics,
- environmental samples from high risk areas (faeces).

For now, there is no ND cases in wild birds population.
