 - Inputs from stakeholders (MS, EFTA countries...)
- Decision process:
 - BTSF scope
 - Activities already planned (scope/contents)
 - Interest at EU level
 - Legal state of play / info from services
 - Budgetary constraints





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- = 2019 work programme
 - ⇒ training actions in 2020-21
- = BTSF financing decision for 2019
 - ⇒ Budget of almost €18 million
