



Surveillance zone:


the remaining part of the Calabrian territory

Three areas are identified on the national territory:

- North Area: Autonomous Provinces of Trento and Bolzano, Valle d'Aosta, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Veneto, Lombardy, Piedmont, Liguria and Emilia Romagna ;
- Center Area: Tuscany, Marche, Lazio, Abruzzo and Molise;
- South Area: Campania, Basilicata, Puglia and Sardinia.





In each area apiaries are clinically controlled twice a year (prev 2% conf 95%)
