






The European Union (34,2 billion €) is the second largest single market after the US (40 billion) and followed by China.

Retail sales value from 2000 to 2017 in bio €







State of play - requests in AAC-FF




Quantity covered by action: over 90 000 tonnes

EU FFN request – ongoing cases


- 45 presence of pesticide residues
- 15 certification /documentation issues
- 2 hygiene issues
- 4 control at the borders/violation of TRACES
- 19 traceability check requests

Suspicions of:

- 'In conversion' sold as organic
- Mixing with conventional
- Mass balance not matching
- Documents/certificates/lab reports
 - Lack
 - Falsified
 - Manipulated
 - Not covering production/surface
 - Expired

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EU FFN results so far...

- *120 administrative investigations*
- *10 judicial investigations*
- *16 000 tons of products downgraded to conventional*
- *9 operators withdrawn/suspended*
- *2 CB's withdrawn in 6 countries*
- *Suspicion of involvement of 7 CBs*
- *3 cases linked to RASFF -> health risk*





National actions results

- 19 judicial investigations
- 6 + 9 people arrested; 2 under investigation
- 105 administrative procedures
- 2 organised criminal groups neutralised (IT, ES)
- Downgraded: 162 tonnes





Challenges

- *Improve cooperation and information exchange*
- *Non-EU countries:*
 - **CA of non-EU country not involved - the power is with control bodies (supervised by DG AGRI)**



Case example – non-EU country



- *Feed material*
 - **Irregularities with organic certification**
 - **Police investigation**
 - **Product confirmed to be sold as conventional in producing country**
- *Citrus with pesticide residues*
 - **Confirmed serious traceability issues and non-organic status of goods; investigation ongoing**



Investigations' results published



Eurojust helps reveal fake organic food fraud

The Hague, 1 July 2019

In close cooperation with Eurojust, Italian and Serbian national authorities unraveled a transnational large-scale fraud in the production and trade of allegedly organic food and beverages from rotten apples. In a successful joint action, coordinated by Eurojust, 9 suspects of an organised crime group (OCG) were arrested. Illegal assets worth €6 million as well as 1,411 tonnes of adulterated product with an estimated value of almost €5 million were seized. 6 companies involved in the criminal activities were searched in the countries concerned.
