ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

1. Resting period on cattle transport: not following the 14:1:14 (adult cattle) or 9:1:9 (calves) schedule but resting much longer than the 1 hour. Mostly 9 hours to comply with the driving and resting times for drivers;
2. Documentation: transport licences/certificates not available; no (correct) transport documents.

ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

Points 1 and 2: continue (risk-based) inspections and enforcement;

Point 2: in 2014, intensified inspections of journey logs and GPS / SNS data resulted in better compliance of the regulation. For the next years, a risk based, selective approach will be followed
