

ASF – MV and BB: Measures and resticted zones




All measures and the restricted zones I and II were established due to an outbreak of African Swine Fever in wild boar in November 2021 in accordance with Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/605.

The restricted zones were established taking into account the recommendations of working paper SANTE/7112/2015/Rev. 3.






Fence lines in restricted zone II before (left) and after (right) adjustment of restricted zones

ASF – MV: Biosecurity regulations in domestic pig establishments

Level	Legislation	Explanation

National	Schweinehaltungshygieneverordnung ("Pig Housing Hygiene Ordinance)	Biosecurity measures for all pig establishments (fattening/breeding); general and specific measures according to farm size; e.g. obligation to obtain approval for free-range pens, requirements for cleaning and disinfection, special requirements for free-range and outdoor systems


ASF – MV: Domestic pigs: additional measures

- •Prohibition of all free-range and outdoor rearing of domestic pigs and wild boars kept in restriction zone II
- •Additional controls on biosecurity measures and the animal health status
- Additional establishments got into the Landes-programmes
- •Additional measures to routine controls on holdings intending to move domestic pigs from holdings in the restricted zones
- Attendance animal loading operations (including sealing the lorry)
- Checking the stock at intervals of maximum 6 months and, in addition to this, carrying out the specified clinical examinations prior to each movement
- •Ensuring the negative results of the examinations of the first two dead pigs per week/ epidemiological unit.
- Attesting
- •Wheel disinfection on arrival and before departure of the truck



ASF – MV: Conclusion

- Jump infection: large spatial distance to the ASF occurrence in feral pigs in BB/SN and POL
- the entry was detected at a very early stage;
- the single detection north of the A24 motorway is to be regarded as an isolated case;
- the genetic relationship to the ASFV-positive animals south of the A24 motorway was proven in this single detection
- the last active ASF case can be dated to mid-July 2022 at the latest and the active event therefore ended in July 2022 at the latest, but probably already a few weeks earlier;
- the spatial distribution of cases covers a relatively small area of about 60 km²;
- Ongoing extensive monitoring showed early on that an active event has been detected




It is concluded that that there is no longer any active ASF activity in the affected area.






ASF positive cases in wild boar in the affected district 24/11/2021-19/05/2023
