Background information

- First and last occurrence till now: 2008 (ICT from France)
- BT free status 2010-2014
- BT reemergence in Europe in 2014
- Awareness campaign for other authorities, breeding associations,
 farmers, large public from August.



Background information


- Ordering surveillance zone around a Romanian protection zone,
 affecting parts of Békés and Csongrád county 26.09.2014.
- First confirmation of BT in Hungary: 14.10.2014. Csongrád county
- Notification: COM, OIE, Croatian and Serbian veterinary authorities

Control measures

- Protection zone of 100 km radius around the outbreaks
- Surveillance zone: 50 km zone around the protection zone
- Measures taken in the zones of 20 km radius around the outbreaks as laid down in Article 4 of Directive
 2000/75/EC, enhanced surveillance within 3 km zone around all outbreaks



Control measures II.

- Ban/restriction on animal movement
- Vector control (treatment with repellents and insecticides) in the 2km radius zone of affected holdings
- Entomological surveillance



Current epidemiological situation

- 23 outbreaks (up to date 30/10/2014)
 - 11 primary
 - 12 secondary
- 3 sheep and 72 cattle found PCR positive



Current epidemiological situation II.

- In three counties:

• Csongrád first: 15/10/2014total: 13 (7 settlements)

• Bács-Kiskun first: 15/10/2014total: 9 (3 settlements)

• Békés first: 25/10/2014total: 1 (1 settlement)

 Vector free period presumably from the end of November.

BTV-4 serotype was confirmed by the EURL.
