# **SITUATION IN SEPTEMBER 2024**

- One outbreak reported on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2024
- Location: Voynika, Yambol region, South-east Bulgaria
- No. of animals: 145 sheep, extensive holding
- Surveillance: 100% of the holdings in the restricted zones were covered by clinical examinations – no spread, approximately 50% of the animals were sampled (1695 samples) – no spread -> the restriction zones elapsed on 4.10



# MEASURES AND ACTIONS APPLIED IN THE AFFECTED HOLDINGS AND IN RESTRICTION ZONES

- Stamping out of all susceptible animals, present in the affected farm, and safe disposal of carcasses, followed by C&D procedures according to Reg. 2020/687.
- Epidemiological investigation to determine the source of infection.
- Census of all farms and susceptible animals in the restriction zones.
- Restrictions beyond the EU requirements in relation to movement restrictions in PZ, SZ and in the BZ. Enhanced official
  controls on movements intended for immediate slaughter and after a clinical examination, temperature measurement
  and permission from an official veterinarian, or of such transiting animals. Control of the official veterinarian on the
  consignments for immediate slaughter of animal from PZ and SZ.
- Meat is subject of treatment in accordance with Annex VII of Reg 2020/687. Disposal of milk.
- Prohibition of fairs, markets and exhibitions (entire country), including grazing (in PZ and SZ).
- Enhanced biosecurity and passive surveillance.
- Clinical examination and sampling (blood and swab samples) in PZ and SZ.
- Clinical examination (5% prevalence (LC 95%) per village) and sampling in case of suspicion (blood and swab samples) in BZ.
- Enhanced passive surveillance and biosecurity, through awareness campaigns targeted to farmers and private veterinarians.
- A compensation for the farmers whose animals had been killed.

#### MEASURES IN THE ADDITIONAL BUFFER ZONES

- Restrictions of trade, movement and transport of small ruminants, except for those subject to immediate slaughter following clinical examination and temperature measurement by an official veterinarian and transit consignments.
- Ban of markets and exhibitions of small ruminants.
- Cleaning and disinfection of the means of transport of the approved movements.
- Census of holdings and animals
- Clinical examinations on village level to detect 5% prevalence with LC 95%.
- Sampling of all suspect animals.

On 18 Oct 2024 the measures were expanded as follows:

#### NATIONAL MEASURES IN THE SOUTH REGIONS



South bordering areas under national restriction measures

- For the affected regions (Stara Zagora, Yambol, Haskovo):
- ban of movement
- ban of grazing
- slaughter only within these regions, under official control pre-movement clinical examination, pre-movement testing, pre-movement certificate issued by an official veterinarian, approval by the RFSD of destination.
- For all south bordering regions possibility for movement for slaughter in a closest slaughterhouse or to another animal holding under the above-described conditions.
- Awareness campaigns
- Epi-commission meetings
- Increase of the biosecurity measures
- Sampling upon suspicion
- Movement control and inspections for illegal movement
- Information and cooperation with border police and custom services


## **OTHER MEASURES**

In the context of epi-situation with PPR in the region, enhanced measures were applied as follows:

- Enhanced clinical examinations of small ruminants in the bordering regions also on the west and north bordering areas of the country.
- Epi-commissions meetings on regional levels (RFSD, local government, police, other stakeholders).
- Ban for trade of small ruminants in live markets.
- Ban of exhibitions or other events with small ruminants.
- Official veterinarians in slaughterhouses to inform the central level of BFSA 24 hours before slaughter of small ruminants.
- Cooperation with the Bulgarian Union of Veterinarians for awareness campaigns
- Instructions to police and joint inspections for illegal animal movements



Since the adoption of the CID, the movement of sheep and goats from the protection, surveillance and further restricted zones to a destination located outside the external perimeter of all those further restricted zones has been prohibited.
