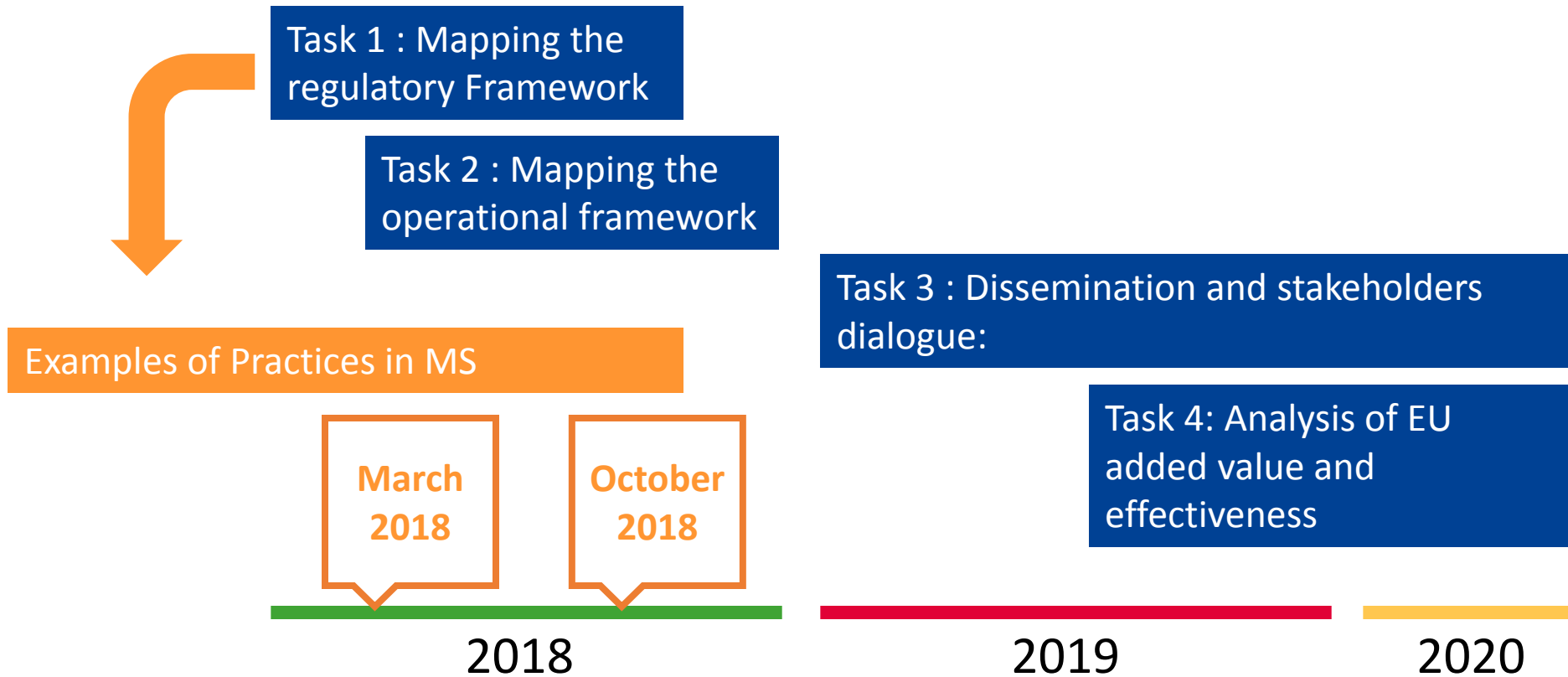

The objective of the session

- To present the document on “Redistribution of surplus food: Examples of practices in the Member States”

The goal of the document

- To support the members of the EU Platform on Food Losses and Waste (FLW) in their national food redistribution actions
- To provide country overviews on how relevant legal provisions (arising from the General Food Law and other relevant policy) are implemented in practice by national-level actors
- To address areas where EU legislation prevails (*e.g.* on food hygiene, food labelling) as well as those governed by national rules (*e.g.* liability, taxation).
- To facilitates information sharing and foster an opportunity for national-level actors to learn about other neighbouring countries' food donation practices



Information consolidation

- Information gathered for Task 1 (national policies, practices, & mechanisms regulating food donation at the national level affecting food redistribution)
 - Input provided by members of the EU Platform on FLW following the call for information issued by DG SANTE on 12 December 2017 and April 2018
 - Input collected by means of expert interviews by researchers from the EU Pilot Project on food redistribution.



Structure of the document

- The structure follows that of the EU guidelines on food donation & organises the available information at the MS level
- The sections mentioned in the brackets next to the actual headings and sub-headings of this document correspond to the sections provided in the EU guidelines on food donation
