# Where are we now?

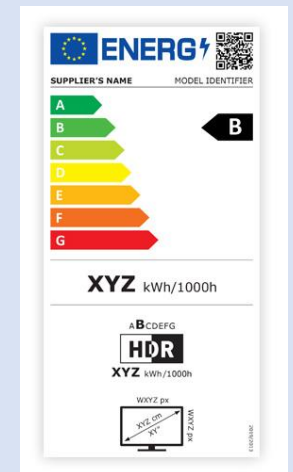
- Consensus for an EU label with key criteria (not only housing)
- Consensus for a multi-tier label
- No consensus for voluntary/mandatory
- **First step is to create a common framework**
- Part of the sustainable food labelling system (composite system)

- Evaluating labels (scoring)



# Why a common framework?

- Animal welfare principles are common to all species
- Levels should be comparable across species
- Technical standards should be dynamic

# Animal Welfare Domains

1. Nutrition: food & water (quantity, quality)
2. Environment: air/water quality, space to move, temperature
3. Health: no diseases, no injuries, no pain
4. Behaviour: positive social contacts, species-specific behaviours,
5. Mental state: positive experiences and mental state

# How comparable across species?

## **Structural criteria Y/N**

1. Management, organisation and procedures
2. Personnel competence and number
3. Facilities and equipment design
4. Monitoring system of performances

# How comparable across species?

## Operational criteria: Indicators (animal or resource based)

1. Scope: Number of domains covered
2. Precision: Number of indicators per domain (?)
3. Results of indicators: minimum – range from 0 to +++
4. Calculating an overall score

# Possible levels?

## **Operational criteria: based on indicators results**

1. Level « - » or « unknown welfare »
2. Level « 0 » or « baseline »
3. Level « + » or « better welfare»
4. Level « ++ » or « much better welfare»
5. Level « +++» or « the best welfare on the market»



# A baseline?

**What?** *“a minimum or starting point used for comparisons”*

**Why?**

- ✓ To compare upgraded levels scientifically
- ✓ To ensure dynamic standards

**How?**

- ✓ EU legislation but
  - Not all domains are regulated in one sector
  - Not all sectors are regulated
- ✓ EU most common practices but
  - Regional diversities
  - Historical differences in achievements
  - How and who should establish them?
